I very much hope that you have managed to have a break over the summer after what seems like a very strange and unusual year. You have all worked so hard at completing your course, and you have all faced the challenges of continuing to study and learn from home with great enthusiasm and maturity. The school is very proud of you all and we look forward to celebrating your achievements.

All KS5 (6th form) results will be available from Thursday 13th August. Given the current situation with Covid-19 we have had to look into the best options for you all to receive your results in a safe and supportive way. Therefore, the following will happen on Thursday 13th.

There will be two main ways for you to receive your results:

- Come to school to collect them in person
- Have them posted to you (you will also receive an email of your results on Thursday)

We need ensure the safety of all our students and staff so please think about which option is best for you.

If you do not come into the school on Thursday, we will post your results but will also send them via email so you can access them straight away. We will also be able to discuss anything regarding your results on the 'phone and give support and guidance where necessary.

If you do choose to come into the school to collect results you must abide by the following:

- Anyone who has coronavirus (Covid-19) symptoms, or who has someone in their family who does, cannot enter school premises.
- You must ensure that you sanitize your hands upon entering the building.
- You must, wherever possible, keep 2 metres apart from staff and students.
- You cannot bring family members, friends or relatives into the building and they cannot wait or gather on the car park.
- No one else can collect the results for you unless it has been agreed beforehand. (See email address below)
- You must only attend during the timeslots given below based upon your year group and subject.

You will also be able to receive your grades for any A-levels or Core maths.

Upon entering the building, you will sanitize your hands and then collect your results. There will be support where necessary i.e. next steps and UCAS. However, unless you need to speak to one of the team regarding your results or future plans you will then need to leave the building as soon as possible so we can ensure the appropriate level of social distancing.

I appreciate the frustration that we all have at these times, but I assure you that the school will do everything we can to support and congratulate you in a safe manner.
